Since 1979, the Mont-Blanc Marathon has been committed to the environment. This year, to reinforce this commitment, 40% of the race bibs have been reserved for runners coming by train or bus to encourage sustainable mobility. To make it easier for you to get around during the event, the Chamonix Sports Club is providing extra buses and trains.

As a committed partner, ATMB is helping to finance the shuttle buses for runners and accompanying persons and to improve transport services during the event. Additional buses will be put in place to facilitate travel for the 40,000 participants and spectators.

As a main partner, New Balance is supporting the Chamonix Sports Club in organising an eco-responsible event by financing additional trains to help runners and their companions get around more easily.

Public transport



The Chamonix Valley is served all year round by a public transport network comprising various bus routes and the Mont-Blanc Express train.







SHUTLLES OVERNIGHT RETURNS (M)

From 8.30pm until 1am, a Chamo'nuit bus service, which costs €4.50, will serve all the towns in the valley.

Once the Chamo'nuit bus service is finished, the organisers will provide free shuttle buses for runners **between Les Houches and Argentière from 1.30am until 5am (departing approximately every 30 minutes.)** If you wish to use them, please let the staff at the aid station know at the end of your race.





Regarding the Mont-Blanc 10km, regular lines 1 and 2, as well as the Mont-Blanc Express train, will serve Chamonix. 





PLEASE NOTE: access to the Tour village by car is closed during the event!


